CODICIL

(1) I hereby amend my said will by adding a new paragraph at the end thereof

[OPTION ONE]

[OPTION TWO]

[OPTION THREE]

I give and bequeath to BUNCOMBE STREET UNITED METHODIST CHURCH ENDOWMENT FUND, INC. the property described in the attached Exhibit which has been initialed and dated by me.

(2) Ratification. As amended by this Codicil, I hereby confirm, ratify and republish my said will dated Dec 30, 2014.
