Five is highest score possible in any area; three is an average score in any area; and 0 is the lowest possible score in any area- 4,2,1's may be used as well. Should there be a tie the applicant in the tie with the most need will be awarded the scholarship.

Item Number Two – Minister’s Recommendation: You must have sent directly to the stated address to be received by the July 12, 2015 deadline date a letter of recommendation from one of the ministers at Buncombe Street UMC.



Item Number Three – High School Teacher or College Professor or Recent Employer Recommendation: You must have sent directly to the aforementioned stated address to be received by the July 12, 2015 deadline date a letter of recommendation from one of these persons

- a high school teacher or a college professor who has taught you this academic year;
- or a recent employer if you have not been in school the last two years.
