MOPPETS VOLUNTEER FAQs



Your interest in becoming a MOPPETS Volunteer is greatly appreciated. MOPPETS Volunteers are a vital part of MOPS! MOPS moms will only be able to relax, rejuvenate, and enjoy MOPS if they know the MOPPETS volunteers are caring for their children in the best possible way. Here are some of the most frequently asked questions regarding this important role...

What does a MOPPET Volunteer do?

MOPPET Volunteers provide a loving and safe environment for the children in the MOPPETS program. They take every opportunity to tell children that Jesus loves them. We have children ranging in age from a few months old to five years old and we need volunteers in each of our four different childcare rooms. Depending on the age group, this may include administering a lesson or activity that has been prepared by the MOPPETS Team Leader. Volunteers follow BSUMC's established policies and procedures and are usually paired with a BSUMC staff nursery worker.

What is the time commitment?

Volunteers are needed from 9:15 am to 11:30 am when BSUMC MOPS meets, which is generally the 1st & 3rd Monday during the school year (see exact dates). Ideally, the same familiar faces would greet the children in the MOPPETS program each time but there are options to meet any schedule – twice monthly, once a month, every third meeting, etc.

What are the requirements to become a MOPPET Volunteer?

Currently, all MOPPETS Volunteers need to have passed the BSUMC background check. If you have previously had a background check conducted at BSUMC, you should qualify. If you are unsure if you've had a background check completed, we can check and let you know.
